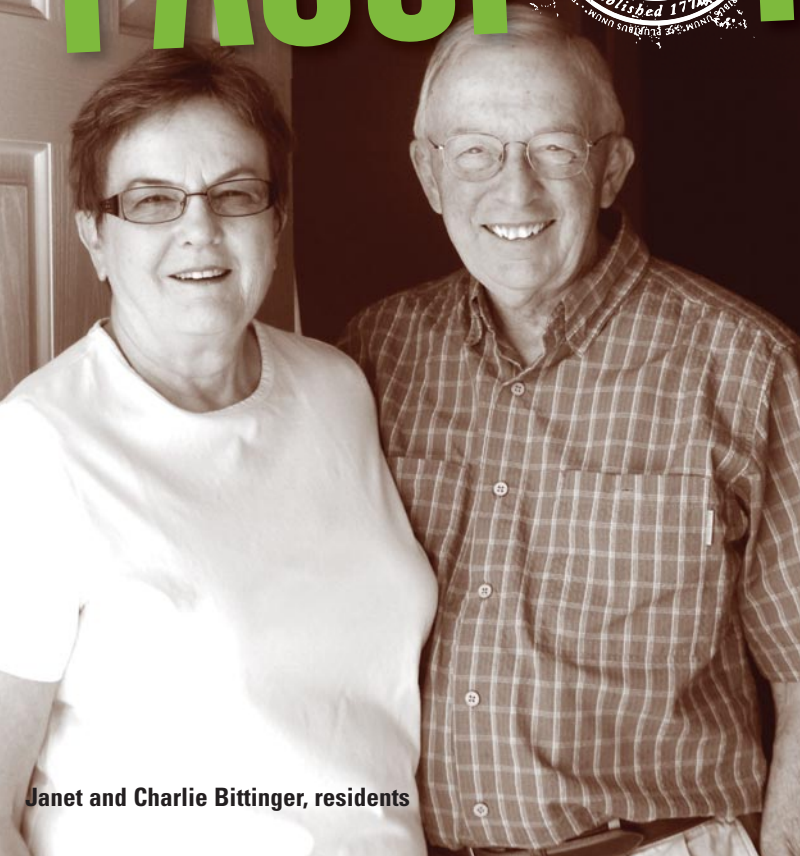


PASSPORT TO TRAVEL
